Title of Consultancy: Develop a training manual on anti-corruption assessment techniques targeting government ministries (education and health care sector)
Time Frame for assignment: 20 days

1. Introduction

Transparency International Zimbabwe (TI Z) is a non-profit, non-partisan, systems-oriented local chapter of the international movement against corruption. Its broad mandate is to fight corruption and related vices through networks of integrity in line with the Global Strategy. TI Z believes corruption can only be sufficiently tackled by all citizens including people at grass root level.

2. Background

Corruption hinders the realisation of all human rights – civil, political, economic, social, and cultural, as well as the right to development. Instructively corruption violates the core human rights principles of transparency, accountability, non-discrimination, and meaningful participation in every aspect of the life of the community. their demand for the respect of human rights. Zimbabwe’s political administration has been battling with efforts of strengthening institutions that respond to corruption. These institutions include, local authorities, health sector, education sector and anti-corruption institutions such as Zimbabwe Anti-corruption commission. However, of concern for citizens have been reports of high levels of corruption and impunity within these sectors. There is anecdotal evidence concerning the rise of petty and grand levels of corruption in the education and health care sector. TI Z believes that there is a need to strengthen the public sector (particularly the education and health sector) through improving knowledge and skills of government officials to detect and address corruption vulnerabilities and loopholes in the service delivery. It is in this background that TI Z seeks the services of a consultant to develop a training manual on anti-corruption assessment techniques for senior government officials.

3. Deliverables

The consultant/s will develop a training manual which will act as an illustrative training tool which enables stakeholders, particularly government officials to identify corruption risks and vulnerabilities. The training manual will be used by TI Z staffers as part of their training module.

Timeframe

The anticipated level of effort for the consultancy is 20 days.

Terms of payment

TI Z will make payment for the assignment upon satisfactory completion of the task. Remuneration will be disclosed to shortlisted applicants.
